

# The Eastern Window

**Editor's Note:** Cross ventilation produces a breath of fresh air. It is desirable in a house and even in a magazine! In this spirit, we are featuring a series of short articles designed to make some of the basic building blocks and ideas of Vedic astrology more accessible to all. We anticipate that opening the Eastern Window can clarify the complementarity between great astrological traditions.

## The Power of Illusion (or is it the Illusion of Power?): Rahu, Ketu, and the Wizard of Oz

Eclipse — a most spectacular, terrifying, hoodwinking, conjuring, phantasmal, astronomical event. The disappearance of the Sun, the bloodying of the Moon. Reality or illusion? If what you see is what you get, it is both. The eclipse spectacle shows great invention and innovation, an extensive range of possible presentations, intensity, charisma, and a radically altered view of the cosmos.

And the illusionists? Those ambitious tricksters, Rahu and Ketu. They have no substance, are shadowy outsiders; but yet, there is power in the confusion they wreak, in the manipulation and misconceptions. Yes, illusion is potent, and the purveyors can whip up the masses, disguise reality, and become “Oz, the Great and Powerful.”

The creation story of Rahu, Ketu, and the Churning of the Ocean<sup>1</sup> conveys these characteristics. Myths embody important realities and even astronomical principles, enabling wisdom to be passed down through generations. For example, a lovely TED Talk<sup>2</sup> speaks to a stunning link between the Moon’s affinity for *Rohini* (one of his 27 wives) and the frequency with which Rohini (the Sanskrit name for the fixed star Aldebaran) is occulted (covered) by the Moon. Rohini is the marking star for the *nakshatra* (lunar constellation) that bears its name.<sup>3</sup> In a

similar way, the astrological effects of eclipses on a native or a society can be gleaned from this myth.

Though dramatic eclipses visible at the time of birth are obviously quite rare, every chart contains, and must contend with, Rahu and Ketu. Their DNA brings themes implicit in the creation myth into the individual’s destiny pattern. There are endless permutations and outcomes that Rahu and Ketu can create in the ecosystem we call a chart. Let’s look at a few themes that Rahu and Ketu bring forward, or color, in the horoscopes of two famous natives.

### Amy Winehouse

Not only are Rahu and Ketu straddling the 1st–7th house axis (see **Chart 1**, below), Amy was actually born in a Ketu *dasha* (planetary period) and Rahu *bhukti* (sub-period).<sup>4</sup> (See **Table 1**, below right.) The encircling “embrace” of the dragon seemed inevitable — a compelling portrait of destiny and karma.

Amy’s incredible talent was evident from the beginning as was her maladjustment to societal norms. Unfortunately, she became a member of the infamous 27 club, a group of young celebrities who passed away at 27 years old; Amy succumbed to alco-

hol poisoning after a long battle with drug and alcohol addictions.

Why are the effects of the nodes in this chart so dramatic? Not only is the Rahu–Ketu axis across the 1st–7th house axis, Rahu is debilitated and Ketu is exalted, which exaggerates their effects. All of the *grahas* (planets) except for the Moon are “in the belly of the snake,” a pattern known as *Kala Sarpa Yoga*

(black cobra yoga).<sup>5</sup> The lord of the *lagna* (Ascendant) is Venus, which is powerful because it is retrograde, but heavily afflicted by its *yuti* (association) with debilitated Mars and the *drishti* (aspect) by exalted Saturn. It is also in the nakshatra of Ashlesha, whose deity is *Sarpa* (the snake). Venus is in the very last degree (29°35') of the water *rashi* (sign) of Cancer — a perilous no-man's land between the junction of water and fire rashis, where grahas are vulnerable.

Amy's pattern is particularly intense, manifesting in her physical appearance, her voice, and persona. She was hypnotic, fascinating, compelling, utterly innovative, and iconic. Her influence pervades the pop scene to this day and is especially notable in superstars like Lady Gaga.

### L. Ron Hubbard

L. Ron Hubbard (LRH), Dianetics, and the Church of Scientology also epitomize these nodal themes. While supporters portray him as a pioneer, nuclear physicist, philosopher, world traveler, and writer — most of the world, including many governments, saw his movement as a powerful and lucrative cult that gave him uncanny power over his minions. The organization, it is said, seduced followers with the vision of rehabilitating their omnipotent and perfect self through techniques and devices invented by LRH. So, it is not surprising that his biographies have titles like: *L. Ron Hubbard: Messiah or Madman?*

He transformed himself from a writer of very idiosyncratic science fiction into a guru, conferring upon the faithful his spiritual scriptures, the Red and Green volumes (a collection of his writings, tapes, etc.). Control was absolute, and the organization raked in millions in what has been described as a mafia-like global racket — complete with intimidation, lawsuits against any opposers, corruption, smoke and mirrors, and lies.

Eventually, he had to spend his life at sea to avoid “all the people after him.”<sup>6</sup> After eight years, he went into hiding in numerous places, moving on when his whereabouts were disclosed. His last years (he died in 1986 at age 74) were spent in a motorhome on a ranch, continuing to write and run the church,<sup>7</sup> which has carried on unabated to the present time.

The chart of LRH is fascinating. (See **Chart 2**, below left.) Let's start with the Scorpio *lagna* — a rising *rashi* that is well known for power, secrets, magic, and something unsettling. The rising nakshatra of Jyeshtha furthers the narrative, as the mighty Indra is the deity who becomes drunk with power. A talisman is the symbol for this nakshatra, intimating divine protection provided by powerful unseen forces.

Hubbard's *lagna* lord is an exalted Mars in the 3rd *bhava* (house) with no influence on it other than a tight relationship with debilitated Saturn sitting with Rahu in the 6th *bhava*. Both the 3rd and the 6th *bhavas* welcome malefics and provide the native with increased courage and even brashness, especially when the malefics are in exaggerated states like exaltation and debilitation. Indeed, it was in May 1950 during his Mars–Rahu *dasha*–*bhukti* period (see **Table 2**, below left) that he published *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health*, which launched the movement that would later morph into the Church of Scientology.<sup>8</sup> Jupiter, as the 2nd-house lord of speech, is in the 12th house in the Rahu–Ketu axis and aspected by that debilitated Saturn. This can be seen as a signature for deceptive speech bundled in skillful spiritual wrappings.

Though his last ten-plus years were during his Jupiter *dasha*, he spent the bulk of his life in the Rahu *dasha*, fulfilling his destiny as the unstable genius who would unleash one of the most controversial, grandiose, out-of-the-mainstream movements in modern history. It is a life that perfectly reflects Rahu's insatiable desire for power and immortality. L. Ron Hubbard — the Wizard of Oz!
